County Facts

Mosquito County was formed in 1824. It was renamed Orange County 21 years later for the abundant, quality fruit that constituted the county's main product.

With more than 146,000 acres of the 637,783 acres in Orange County being considered farmland, agriculture and natural resources has a \$4,122 million output impact and creates approximately 33,051 jobs.
